 - Show Web Inspector





Selector	Example	Example description
<u>.class</u>	.intro	Selects all elements with class="intro"
<u>#id</u>	#firstname	Selects the element with id="firstname"
*	*	Selects all elements
<u>element</u>	р	Selects all elements
element,element	div, p	Selects all <div> elements and all elements</div>
element element	div p	Selects all elements inside <div> elements</div>
element>element	div > p	Selects all elements where the parent is a <div> element</div>




Javascript pop-up notification

- For browser programming:
 - alert(string)
 - no print function
- Example (from address bar):
 - javascript:alert(4+5)

Safari doesn't allow JavaScript from the Smart Search Field.

To allow this, choose "Allow JavaScript from Smart Search Field" from the Develop menu.



- Changing the html document:
 - document.write(string)
 - html_element.innerHTML = "string"

overwrites html document modifies html_element
